Groups fund energy efficiency program in Alger County + SHARE

ALGER COUNTY, MI (WNMU) - Three agencies are teaming up to help Alger County residents save money and protect public lands at the same time.

The Alger Energy Savers program is funded through the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore, and Superior Watershed Partnership and Land Trust.

Those who sign up will receive a home energy assessment from a contractor, who will identify ways to increase energy efficiency, install free efficiency measures like light bulbs, pipe wrap, and faucet aerators, and discuss more ways to save energy.

Program Manager Natasha Koss says the measures could reduce CO2 emissions by 19-thousand tons, or the equivalent of the emissions from nearly two million gallons of gasoline.
