## Partnership monitors Huron River

On May 30, the Huron River Watershed Partnership conducted a one-day stream monitoring event to collect physical and biological data from Lake Superior's Huron River in Baraga County. Twenty volunteers attended an on-site training session and collected data at seven sites. Following collection of data, volunteers participated in an indoor macroinvertebrate identification session. Data and information collected during the event will be used to document water quality and aquatic habitat conditions in the Huron River and its tributaries.
