Meeting to get input on lake

MARQUETTE — The Superior Watershed Partnership, in cooperation with Northern Initiatives and Lt. Gov. John Cherry, has announced that a public input meeting will be held at 7 p.m. Oct. 13 in the Great Lakes rooms of the University Center at Northern Michigan University.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather local and regional input for Michigan's Great Lakes Restoration and Protection Initiative.

In June of this year, Lt. Gov. Cherry joined the Michigan Office of the Great Lakes and Michigan United Conservation Clubs to announce the initiative in Lansing, which has since led watershed alliances, sportsmen's organizations, tribal entities and other non-governmental and governmental stakeholders to participate in developing a framework for a comprehensive restoration and protection plan for Michigan.
